Document Management

Jack Hudson of Hudson-James Inc. provided a demonstration of the OnBase document management solution.

Document management systems are software applications from a family of Hudson James Incorporated products which electronically capture, store, and manage every document generated or received by your district – including paper, reports, forms, emails, application files, and web content. Document management software handles everything you need to do with those documents – retrieve, view, annotate, distribute, publish, or post to your website. Hudson James’ document management applications are designed to integrate with your existing applications and processes to create a single point of online access to all relevant information.

The NEOnet consortium is considering the purchase of this solution. Costs associated with this solution consist of the following: hardware, software, user licenses, training and support. An optional scanner is available and is considered a separate cost. The price per district does include a total of 4 user licenses. User licenses can be customized per district need.
