Online Banking and Investments

Banking service needs and competitive transaction fees were discussed.

New Communication Suite, Calendaring, Email, and Instant Messaging

This new communication suite only impacts Mogadore as of right now. Other districts will soon follow. This is all part of NEOnet's ISP fees, so there is no extra cost to each district.

County Fiber Network

The final approval for the fiber network will be made at the November 1, 2004 assembly meeting. The cost of changing over to fiber from T1 lines will probably not be feasible for smaller districts.

NEOnet Governance

A discussion was held concerning the advantages of NEOnet becoming a Council of Governments. This issue will be further discussed at the November 2004 Treasurers meeting.
